

Uniform Policy 2018 – 2019

Introduction

The Governors and all members of staff at Regina Coeli expect all pupils to adhere to the uniform policy, wear their uniform with pride and take care of it.

Labelling

ALL clothing must be clearly labelled, including socks, PE kit and bags. Please check termly and be aware even indelible markers wash out eventually.

Winter Uniform

Boys: green pullover (crest optional), grey trousers (long or short), grey socks, white shirt and school tie.

Girls: green cardigan or pullover (crest optional), brown skirt or tunic, brown or green socks or tights. In the summer Term and the first part of the Autumn Term you have the option to send your children to school in summer uniform. Sensible sandals are also permissible. Both boys and girls should have their jumpers or cardigans in school as well as a sensible coat.

Summer Uniform 2

Boys: as above apart from white polo shirt instead of shirt and tie. Sensible Sandals (see below).

Girls: green cardigan or pullover (crest optional), green and white checked dress and white socks.

Shoes

Shoes (**NOT BOOTS**) should be black or brown and should have flat heels. In the summer sandals may be worn with socks. Sandals should have a closed heel and toe (see below).



Coats

Coats must be brown, dark green or black, and plain with no markings or logos (other than school crest). These must be in school every day – even if it is sunny in the morning. The British weather is unpredictable and every wet & windy day we have a few children without proper outside attire. School fleeces are an acceptable outer layer in the summer months, but are not a replacement for either a proper coat or a school jumper.

PE Girls and Boys

FS/KS1: black plimsolls, white T-shirt or polo shirt, white shorts

KS2: trainers, school tracksuit, yellow Regina Coeli T-shirt, dark green shorts, white socks.

Bags

EYFS & KS1: Children should only use the Regina Coeli book bags (no rucksacks)

KS2: Children may use the small Regina Coeli rucksacks.

Swimming

Year 4,5 & 6. Swimming dark coloured swimming costumes or trunks. All children have to wear swimming hats.

Hats, Gloves and Scarves

If you require your child to wear these in winter, they must be plain, practical and in brown or dark green. During very hot weather, children should wear suitable summer hats. Sensible hats are permissible on the playground to help avoid the sunshine. Sunglasses are not permitted without a letter from a doctor or the parent giving a medical explanation.

We are not permitted to administer sun lotion, so please do this at home if necessary. There are always shady areas where children can sit on sunny days.

Hair and Nail Varnish

Hair must be a suitable conventional style. The use of hair gel or mousse, or any colouring is not permitted. Long hair must be completely tied back. Please note that scrunchies or hairbands etc. must be in school colours – brown or dark green. No further ornamentation is permitted. Nail varnish may not be worn at school and must be removed after the weekend.

Jewellery

No chains, medals and wrist wear (with the exception of watches) may be worn. Simple watches are permitted but the school cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage. Earrings may be worn but may only be small gold or silver studs. **All earrings will have to be removed for PE.** Please make sure that if you wish to have your child's ears pierced it is done at the beginning of the summer holidays. Any child wearing earrings that are unsuitable for school will be asked to remove them.

School Uniform List at a Glance

All children

Boys

- Summer – white polo shirt instead of shirt and tie

Girls

- Green cardigan or pullover (crest optional)
- Brown skirt or tunic
- Brown socks or green or brown tights
- Summer – green and white checked dress and white socks
